Heroes MAKE America, Ft. Bragg is an 8-week program offered in partnership with Fayetteville Technical Community College's Transition Tech Program.

- Certifications include: Certified Production Technician (CPT), OSHA 10 and Forklift Operation with essential manufacturing credentials: safety, quality, maintenance, manufacturing processes and production
- Weekly modern manufacturing tours
- Career readiness instruction - resume writing, interview skills, LinkedIn training
- Placement Support - connections and guidance during career search and interview process

Service members within 180 days of separation/retirement, National Guard and Reservists, honorably discharged veterans and eligible military spouses
