

DoDI 1322.29 (24 Jan 14)

- Defines DoD wide who can participate
- Policy is established at the DoD level

AR 600-81 Ch. 8 (17 May 16)

- Expect to receive honorable or general discharge
- No legal or flag action pending (e.g. Art-15)
- Become eligible 180 days from actual **Separation Date**
- Release by 1st field grade officer with UCMJ authority
- Extension for the purpose of CSP is not authorized
- Place of duty is with the training provider

Ft. Bragg Procedures

- Completed/scheduled pre-separation, DOL, MOS crosswalk, VA, budget and capstone prior to enrollment
- Little to no cost to the government and the Service Member
- CSPs tie to an opportunity

PTDY (09 Dec 16)

- Up to 120 days
- All associated expenses are the responsibility of the Service member
- Can't be used in conjunction with other leaves or passes
