- Safety

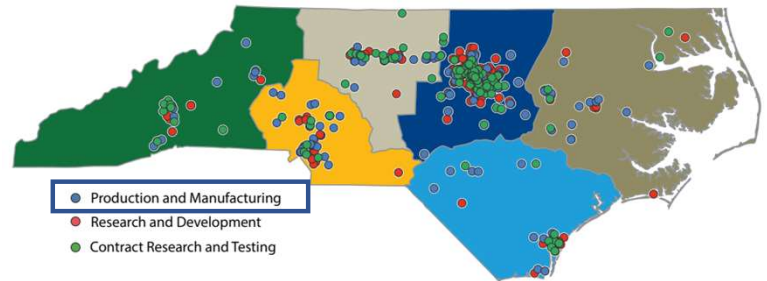
