Notes:

1. We observed an overall decrease in crime due in large part to COVID-19 restrictions during the 3rd & 4th quarter of FY 20.

2. *Overall Soldier crime rate at Fort Bragg, per 100,000 Soldiers, was 47% lower than FORSCOM & 18% lower than Army as a whole.

3. * Soldier crime rates decreased by 56% from FY13-20 and 27% from FY 19-20.

Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Board

Main Hospital Urgent Care Clinic/COVID in Person Clinic

✓ Hours of operation are Monday – Friday, 0700-1900

Main Hospital COVID-19 Diagnostic Testing

 Centralized COVID-19 Testing for those with symptoms in the Main Hospital Emergency Room, 24 hours / 7 days a week.

COVID In Person Care (Drive Thru—Requires Appointment)

- ✓ Asymptomatic patients with possible exposure can call 910-907-2778 to schedule a virtual appointment with a provider to discuss COVID-19 drive-thru testing options.
- ✓ Asymptomatic patients who are preparing to deploy, returning from deployment, training, or have occupation requirements can call 910-907-1011 to schedule drive-thru testing appointments.
- ✓ Drive-thru testing site is at WAMC near the emergency department. Testing by appointment is available Monday through Friday (except federal holidays), from 0800 1100 and 1300 1500.
- ✓ Patients that may have other non-COVID-19 medical issues, please call the appointment line at 910-907-2778 and request a virtual appointment.

2 COVID-19 Vaccines are approved by the FDA for Emergency Use Authorization (EUA)

- **Pfizer-BIONTECH** and **Moderna** (both mRNA vaccines)
 - Currently only the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine is being administered at FBNC under EUA
 - 2-dose vaccine series given 21 days apart
 - Contains no preservatives or latex
 - Prior COVID-19 disease vaccinate
 - Known SARS CoV-2 exposure vaccinate
 - Current COVID-19 delay vaccination (so as not to expose others)
 - Both doses are necessary for full protection (95% efficacy 1 week after 2nd dose)
 - Persons who have had an anaphylactic reaction to the 1st dose of a COVID-19 vaccine should not receive further doses.
 - An allergic reaction to any other vaccine or injectable therapy, or anaphylaxis for any cause, is a precaution to COVID-19 vaccination.
 - A history of an allergic, non-anaphylactic, reaction to a non-injectable medicine, food, latex, or pollen does not preclude receipt of a COVID-19 vaccine.
 - Pregnancy: Experts recommend that COVID-19 vaccines should not be withheld from pregnant individuals who meet criteria for vaccination.
 - Breastfeeding: Experts recommend that COVID-19 vaccines should be offered to lactating individuals similar to non-lactating individuals when they meet criteria for receipt of the vaccine.



Novavax Phase 3 FDA-regulated Investigational Vaccine Clinical Trial also ongoing at FBNC

- Novavax Vaccine is a more traditional vaccine (protein subunit with a novel adjuvant)
- WAMC/FBNC chosen as 1 of 115 sites across the US for this clinical trial
- Additional vaccines are required to meet the global needs to combat COVID because no single vaccine is right for everyone
- The Novavax trial is a placebo-controlled trial, so enrollment will be focused on at-risk individuals who are not included in the "first waves" of distribution of EUA vaccines
- It is not anticipated that EUA vaccine doses will be available for the broad population in the US for several months. Thus, you may still want to participate in this trial, in which you have a 2 out of 3 chance to receive active vaccine immediately.
- Novavax has proposed to the FDA a modification to this trial design to provide the alternate study injections to all study participants after efficacy has been confirmed. This would be accomplished in what is called a "blinded crossover," meaning that study participants who initially received placebo would receive active study vaccine, and those who initially received active vaccine would receive placebo.
- You may be eligible to participate if you are 18 years or older, an MHS/Tricare beneficiary, medically stable, and do not have a previous confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19
- If you join the clinical trial, you would be randomly assigned (by chance) to receive 2 separate injections into your upper arm (21 days apart) of either the investigational vaccine or placebo.
- Volunteers will be compensated for their participation.

Sports Complex Plan


- Partnership between City of Fayetteville and Fort Bragg
