AIC is a week long course where you will meet your assigned sponsor and become familiarized with the Division's history and culture. Upon completion of AIC you will report to the 1st Brigade Combat Team Headquarters located in Bldg C-2729 on Ardennes Street.

You and your Family are an integral part of the Devil team and we want to ensure you have a smooth transition into 1st BCT and the Fort Bragg area.
