8. Hazing and Bullying. You are prohibited from hazing or bullying others. You may report hazing or bullying to the chain of command, IG, or CG's hotline at 910-396-2677. See Policy Letter #10
9. Alcohol and Cadre Relations. Barracks Soldiers are prohibited from storing or consuming alcohol in the footprint, including the barracks, parking lot and pavilion. Illegal drug and alcohol use is pursuant to UCMJ. There will be no fraternizing between Cadre and in-processing Soldiers regardless of rank. See Policy Letter #11
10. Off-Limits Establishments. You are prohibited from the published list of Fort Bragg off-limits establishments. See FBNC Off-Limits Establishments
11. Uniform. You must conform to AR 670-1 standards. Barracks Soldiers will remain in uniform until released for the day. Fleece caps are not authorized unless directed by 18RC Cadre.
12. Barracks. All single E-5 and below will be assigned a barracks room.
a. Responsibilities. You will sign for linens, a pillow, and a room key. You will receive a statement of charges if you fail to return these items.
b. Room Cleanliness. Common areas will be clean at all times. Sweep and mop your room, empty the trash, make your bed, and clean the bathroom daily. Secure Army-issued gear in your assigned room. Cadre will conduct room inspections on weekdays at 0730 and 1500, prior to shipping, and unannounced. Be outside of your room ready for inspection at 0730 on weekdays, and at 1500 unless otherwise engaged with in-processing activities.
c. Restrictions. Male Soldiers are not allowed in the female barracks. Female Soldiers are not allowed in the male barracks. The 3 rd Brigade barracks are strictly prohibited. Tobacco use is prohibited in the barracks, including cigarettes, cigars, chewing tobacco, vaping, etc. No flammable items will be stored in the barracks, including candles, torches, burners, incense, hot plates, etc. Do not touch fire alarms or smoke detectors.
d. Personally Owned Weapons (POWs). Barracks Soldiers will declare all POWs and store them in the 18RC Arms Room. You will have 5 business days to register POWs with the Fort Bragg Visitor Center outside All American Gate.
