

TSC INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLEANING ISSUED EQUIPMENT PRIOR TO RETURN

All equipment issued by or received from the TSC will be cleaned in accordance with the following instructions. Any item not appropriately cleaned will be refused and rescheduled for turn-in.

RESCUE RANDY: The Randy surface will be cleaned of any tape, tape residue, all traces of pen, marker or paint. The Randy needs to be wiped down and free of dirt. The surface can be cleaned with simple green, soft scrub, clorox wipes, goo gone or similar products. Do not pick up mannequins by the head. If the unit loses or damages arms or legs beyond repair, the unit will purchase replacement parts for repair. If the unit damages the Randy beyond repair, the unit is responsible for purchasing a new Randy. The cost of a Randy is \$1,850.

TC3X: The TC3X surface will be clean; it needs to be wiped down and free of dirt. The surface can be cleaned with simple green or similar products. The case and all compartments will be clean of any items or debris not issued with the TC3X. The TC3X must be drained and should not have any liquid in it. The operator must be present for turn-in to test equipment. If the TC3X has liquid, the TSC will not accept the equipment and will reschedule the unit's turn-in appt. **For large exercises, such as E3B, the senior Medic will sign for the TC3X and will be responsible. The cost of the TC3X is \$85,990.

MOULAGE KITS: All components in the Moulage kit will be cleaned of medical tape, coagulant or any medical compounds adhered to the surfaces. The kit and its individual compartments will be clean of any items or debris not issued with the Moulage kit.

CCMCK BOLTS and MASKS: All bolts will be returned to the TSC rust free and lightly oiled in the individual plastic cases. Protective masks will be returned intact and not cut or altered.

MILES GEAR: MILES gear will be returned clean and dry. Cases will be clean of any items or debris not issued with the MILES equipment. All MILES gear will be repacked as issued. (10) Halos and (10) Harnesses divided on each side of the case, (20) total. Each MILES assembly is issued with (2) CR123A and (1) 1/2AA battery. All batteries will be removed from equipment and packaged for return. Battery caps are to be left open except in the case of a broken wire. All tape, para cord, zip ties and any other fasteners will be removed prior to the unit's turn-in appt. If the MILES gear is not packed properly or has tape, para cord, or zip ties, the TSC will not accept the equipment and will reschedule the unit's turn-in appt. If the unit loses batteries, the unit will purchase replacement batteries. The unit will be financially responsible for cut straps from the Harness, \$36ea.

DUMMY WEAPONS: Dummy weapons and UXOs will be free of dirt, debris, mud and/or substances not present at the time of issue. If equipment is unserviceable, the unit is responsible for replacement cost.

OPFOR/ Clothing: Clothing that has been damaged will be repaired prior to turn-in, i.e., missing buttons, tears or cuts. If the unit cuts off the sleeves or does deliberate damage, the clothing will not be accepted, and the unit is responsible for the replacement cost.
