COL Jared B. Harty is a native of North Beach, MD. He enlisted in the U.S. Army in November 1990 and attended One Station Unit Training at Ft. Benning, GA where he earned the 11B/Infantryman Military Occupational Specialty. After tours with the 3rd U.S. Infantry Regiment (The Old Guard), Ft. Myer, Virginia, and Headquarters, I Corps, Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Washington, he was awarded a 4year Green-to-Gold Scholarship. In 1996, he attended Lincoln University of Jefferson City, MO and was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in the Military Intelligence Corps in May 2000.
