DISCLOSURE: Disclosure is voluntary; however, failure to disclose the information, to include SSN, will result in individual not being allowed to register or store firearms and other privately owned weapons on Fort Bragg. Attempts to keep firearms on Fort Bragg that

## FORT BRAGG WEAPONS REGISTRATION AGREEMENT

(For use of this form see Fort Bragg Regulation 190-11-1. The proponent of this form is DES.

The carrying of a concealed weapon on the installation is prohibited regardless of whether a state or county permit has been obtained. Per AR 190-11, a concealed weapon is any instrument used or designed for the purpose of inflicting grievous bodily harm that is carried on the person in such a way as to be hidden from ordinary view. Folded knives with blades shorter than 3 inches are excluded from this

I understand that in accordance with AR 190-11 to verify individuals are not prohibited from owning a firearm, all individuals who want to register a firearm will have a criminal history conducted to determine eligibility. I understand that if I have been convicted of one of the following that I will not be able to bring or register my weapon on Fort Bragg.

## **EXERPT from AR 190-11, para 4-5.c.:**

- (4) The registration of privately owned firearms by person(s) described below is prohibited:
- (a) Any person convicted of a felony (Gun Control Act of 1968 (Title 18, United States Code, Section 921 et seq. (18 USC 921 et seq.), as amended in 1996 (18 USC 922).
- (b) Any person convicted in any court of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence or a felony (the Lautenberg Amendment to the Federal Gun Control Act of 1968, as amended in 1996).

#### The Amendment:

- 1. Makes it a felony for any person to sell or otherwise dispose of firearms or ammunition to any person he or she knows or has reasonable cause to believe has been convicted of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence.
- 2. Prohibits anyone who has been convicted of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence from shipping or transporting in interstate or foreign commerce, or possessing in or affecting commerce, any firearm or ammunition; or receiving any firearm or ammunition which has been shipped or transported in interstate or foreign commerce.
- (c) Any person who is a fugitive from justice.
- (d) Any person who has been convicted in any court of the possession, use, or sale of marijuana, dangerous or narcotic drugs (the term convicted includes nonjudicial punishment under Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ), Article 15).
- (e) Any person who is presently declared as mentally incompetent or who is presently committed to any mental institution.
- (f) Any civilian or Family member under the age of 18 is prohibited from the use of firearms, unless accompanied and supervised by a parent or legal guardian over the age of 18.

## Storage of privately owned firearms and ammunition

- (1) Firearms belonging to Soldiers living in unit billets (baracks) must be secured in the unit arms room in approved locked containers separate from military AA&E.
- (2) Firearms belonging to personnel residing in leased housing will be secured in either a locked container or provided with a trigger lock. Ammunition for the firearm will be secured separately from the firearm in a locked container.

### Transportation of privately owned firearms and ammunition on Army installations:

- (1) Privately owned firearms will be transported in vehicles only while traveling in a direct route to and from hunting areas, dog training areas, target ranges, or other location authorized by the installation senior commander. No stops are authorized.
- (2) The carrying of a loaded firearm in a vehicle is prohibited.
- (3) Privately owned firearms carried in a vehicle will be secured in the trunk. For vehicles without a trunk, firearms will be encased in a container other than the glove compartment and carried in such a manner that they will not be readily available to the driver or passengers. Commercially available trigger locks and other security devices are strongly recommended to deter and prevent loss and
- (4) If requested by installation law enforcement personnel, individuals will present the registration document when the firearm is out of an approved storage location and being transported on the installation.

- 1. All firearms brought onto the installation will be registered within 24 hours with the DES, Visitor Control Center (VCC) IAW AR 190-11 and FB Reg 190-11-1 (Note: Firearms will not be transported inside the registration building).
- 2. Soldiers are required to have their unit commander complete and sign the unit commander's portion of this form. Officers in pay grade O-3 and above, Warrant Officers CW3 and above, enlisted personnel in pay grade E-8 and above, retired military personnel, and civilian personnel do not require commander's approval and may self approve this form by signing block 13, of page one. Authorized dependents will require sponsor's signature and commander's approval.
- 3. Registration may be completed by:
- a. Manual Complete form and hand carry to the Visitor Control Center (VCC) located at: Bldg. 3550 All American Freeway (910) 432-8193, Sun-Sat during the hours of 0500-2100.
- b. Automated digitally sign and send an encrypted e-mail with the completed form to: usarmy.bragg.id-readiness.list.weapons-registration@army.mil. Once completed, owner will receive registration via return e-mail.
- 4. Registration is not complete until the information is entered into the Army Law Enforcement Reporting & Tracking System (ALERTS).
- 5. If purpose of form is Sportsman Validation, do not submit to VCC until registrant has first registered an account through the Fort Bragg Sportsman website under the same first and last name as shown on this form. Leave block 9 blank if registrant is only requesting a validation for a Fort Bragg Recreation Access Permit.
