

## CSM Daniel Scott Garrison Command Sergeant Major Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Command Sergeant Major Daniel Scott enlisted in the U.S. Army in May 1997 as an Infantryman and graduated One Station Unit Training and Airborne School at Fort Moore, Georgia. CSM Scott has served in leadership positions from rifle team leader to the Senior Enlisted Leader level. He most recently served as the CSM for 1st Squadron, 73rd Cavalry Regiment, 2nd Brigade Combat Team in the 82nd Airborne Division.

CSM Scott was a Ranger Instructor in 4th Ranger Training Battalion and has served in the 10th Mountain Division, 25th Light Infantry Division, 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault) and the 82nd Airborne Division. He deployed to Bosnia-Herzegovina and to Afghanistan three times.

CSM Scott's military education includes the Brigade CSM Pre-Command Course, Sergeants Major Academy, First Sergeant/Company Commander Pre-Command Course, Senior Enlisted Joint Professional Military Education Courses, Senior Leaders Course, Basic and Advanced Noncommissioned Officer Courses, Total Army Instructor Training, Equal Opportunity Course, and Combat Life Savers Course. He is a graduate of the Malaysian Combat Tracker Course.
