BACK TO SHORTLY AFTER WORLD WAR II WHEN THE FIRST ACADEMY WAS
ESTABLISHED IN MUNICH, GERMANY.*

*GENERAL BRUCE C. CLARKE, THEN WITH THE 7TH ARMY, EUROPE,
ASSUMED THE DUTIES AS COMMANDANT, AND IS CONSIDERED THE
FATHER OF THE US ARMY NCO ACADEMIES AROUND THE WORLD.*

*IN THE 1950'S THE EXPANDING WORLDWIDE ROLE OF THE US ARMY
DICTATED THE NEED FOR WELL TRAINED NONCOMMISSIONED OFFICERS.
RECOGNIZING THIS NEED, THE UNITED STATES ARMY AUTHORIZED THE
ESTABLISHMENT OF AN NCO ACADEMY BY EACH CONUS AND OVERSEAS
ARMY.*

*AS A RESULT OF EXPANSION AND DEVELOPMENT, THE XVIII AIRBORNE
CORPS NCO ACADEMY WAS ESTABLISHED ON 1 JANUARY 1972. SINCE ITS
ESTABLISHMENT, THOUSANDS OF NONCOMMISSIONED OFFICERS HAVE
SUCCESSFULLY MET THE CHALLENGES OF THE PROGRAM OF INSTRUCTION
AND HAVE RETURNED TO THEIR UNITS BETTER TRAINED AND PREPARED
