Cleburne, the county seat of Johnson County, is a growing city of 30,000 people on the southwestern edge of the Dallas-Fort Worth area. Cleburne police officers work in partnership with our citizens to promote safe streets and neighborhoods, create a community free from the fear of crime, and improve the overall quality of life.

The City of Cleburne conducts the Police Department Civil Service Examination annually or as needed. This is a written test designed to evaluate knowledge, skills and abilities required for the position of police officer. You are not expected to know police rules, regulations or procedures.

Recruits who are not licensed as Texas peace officers will attend the basic peace officer course (720 hours) followed by 17 weeks of field training.
