- 2. Applicability. This policy is applicable to Military and Civilians assigned or attached to United States Garrison (USAG) Fort Buchanan.
- 3. Purpose. Establish the Open Door Policy.
- 4. Policy.
- a. Soldiers and Civilians are responsible for ensuring their chain of command and commander are made aware of problems that affect discipline, morale, and mission effectiveness.
- b. The Open Door Policy allows members of the command to present facts, concerns, and problems of a personal or professional nature or other issues they have not been able to resolve.
- c. I ask that you try to resolve concerns at the lowest levels and through established channels first.
- d. Members of the command can schedule a meeting through my Administrative Support Assistant. When scheduling, provide at a minimum a brief description of discussion points and background information as appropriate.
