### Decision Making Process

- ◆ In most cases the decision is made & distributed the day/night before
- ◆ Considerations that go into the decision process include: Current Weather Forecast; On/Off Post School Closures; Road Conditions & Clearing of Roads
- ◆ You can get more information regarding Post Operating Status via Fort Campbell Alert!; Garrison App; Official Social Media Facebook/Twitter or Fort Campbell Internet

### Operating Status Options

- ◆ Before the Duty Day Begins - Normal - Post is Open; 2hr Delay or Post is Closed; After the Duty Day Begins - Early Release for Non-Emergency Employees - Operating Status applies to civilian employees only. Soldiers should contact their chain of command for guidance

### What Can You Do?

- ◆ Do not park in the street; Residents are responsible for sidewalks & driveways; *Free!* salt is available; Stay off the roads as much as possible; Have a vehicle emergency kit; Call before you leave to ensure facility is open & Enjoy the snow!
