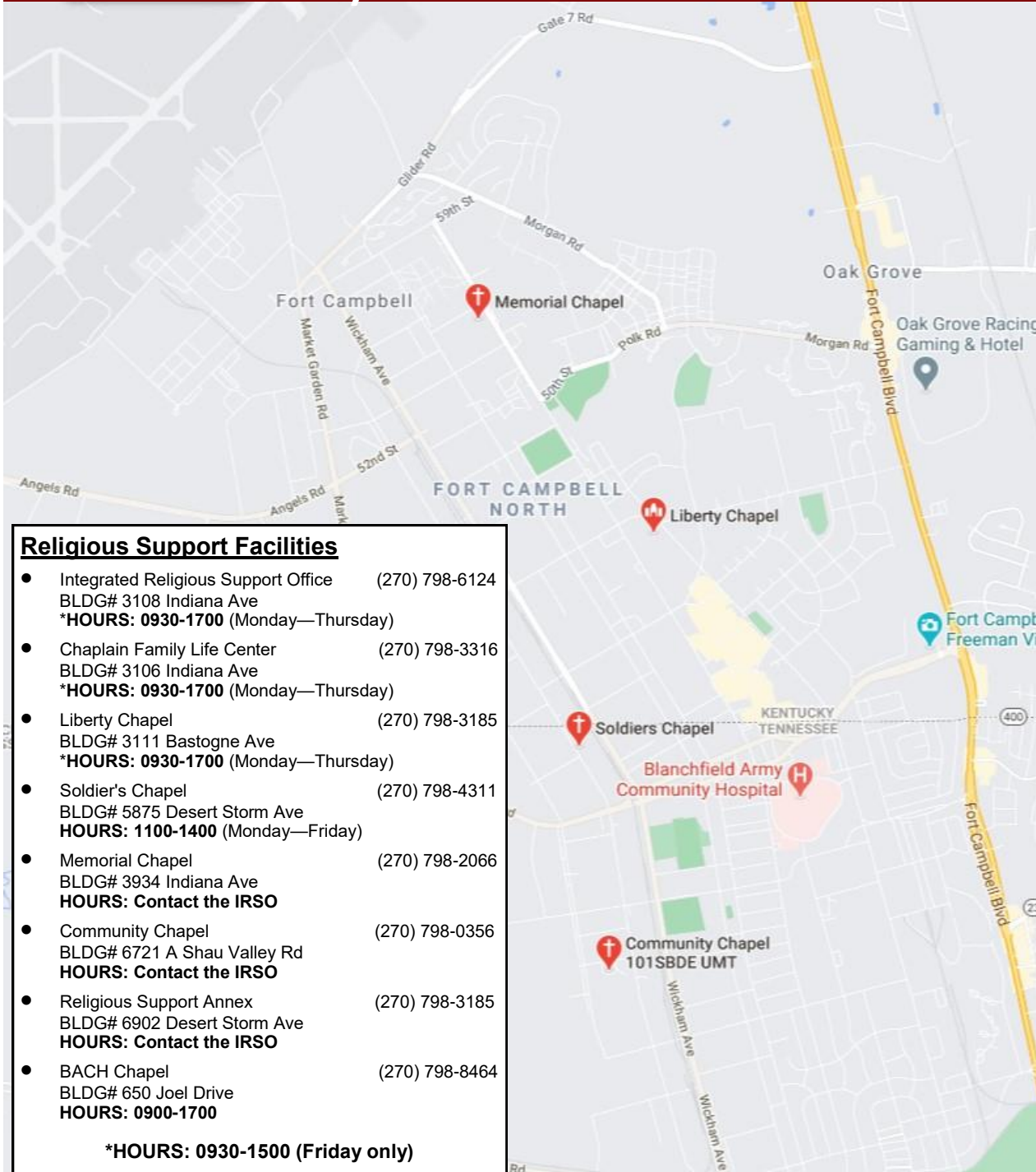

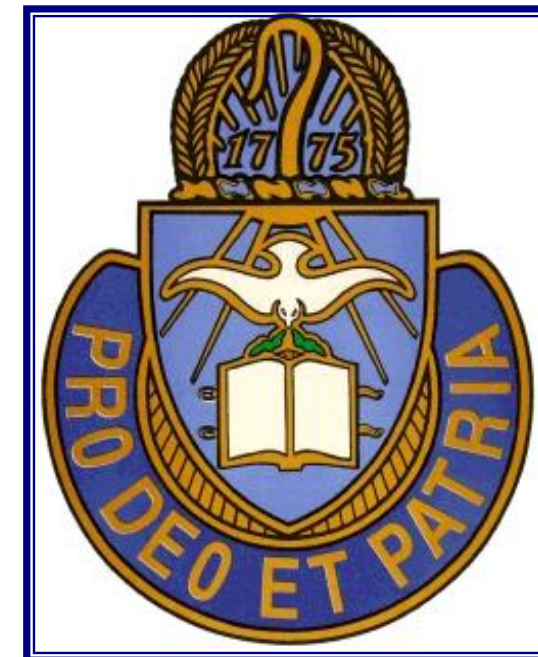

ASK YOUR BUDDY


- Have the courage to ask the question, but remain calm
- Ask your questions directly:
 - Are you thinking of harming yourself?
 - Do you have a plan to kill yourself?

CARE FOR YOUR BUDDY

- Calmly control the situation; **do not** use force; be safe
- Actively listen to show empathy and support
- Remove any means that could be used for self-injury
- Request assistance if needed

ESCORT YOUR BUDDY

- Never leave your buddy alone
- Escort to local emergency room, behavioral health professional, Chaplain, chain of command, or primary care provider
- Call the Military Crisis Line
