• BACH expanded COVID-19 vaccination to all TRICARE eligible beneficiaries age 16 and older - COVID-19 vaccinations are available by appointment only at the Fort Campbell Passenger processing Center located at 7162 Hedgerow Rd

• Schedule your COVID-19 vaccine by going to: <http://blanchfield.tricare.mil> - beneficiaries must use the link on the hospital's website to schedule - Walk-in appointments are not authorized - BACH is using the Pfizer vaccine, which is administered in two doses 21 days apart, so beneficiaries will need to return for the second dose. Second dose appointments may be scheduled through the Dose 2 link on the hospital's website
