Facebook Live Town Hall: Join us Tuesday, Feb. 9, 2022 at 6 p.m. for a Facebook Live Town Hall on the U.S. Army Fort Campbell Facebook page. Blanchfield Army Community Hospital Commander COL Vincent B. Myers will join 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault) Commanding General Maj. Gen. J.P. McGee, Command Sgt. Maj. Veronica Knapp and Fort Campbell Garrison Commander COL Andrew Jordan to provide members of the community the latest updates and answer questions.

Holiday Schedule: In recognition of the upcoming President's Day holiday, BACH personnel will observe the federal holiday Monday, Feb. 21. Therefore, all primary and specialty care services and pharmacies will be closed. The Emergency Center, inpatient services, as well as supportive supplementary services will remain open to provide inpatient, acute and emergency medical care.

Blood Drives: There is always a great need for blood donations, but now more than ever as our nation experiences a critically low blood supply the need is now a greater-than-ever.

Armed Services Blood Program: January was National Blood Donor Month and the Armed Services Blood Program is making a call to action to all eligible blood donors within the military community to donate as this year's awareness campaign running through February. The Armed Services Blood Program is the official blood collection, manufacturing and transfusion program for the U.S. military and the provider of blood and blood products to the U.S. armed forces. A team will host a drive at Fort Campbell's Soldier Support Center in March. More information will be shared soon.

COVID-19 Testing:

After the holidays, we experienced an increased demand for COVID-19 testing, increasing the time it took beneficiaries to receive an appointment for a COVID test. Offering drive thru testing without appointments helped meet the demand. Once the demand decreases, scheduling COVID testing appointments will be available again. We appreciate your patience as the increased demand resulted in longer wait times at the test site. Our care teams are working as efficiently as possible to support beneficiaries going through the test site.

In the event you require a COVID-19 test, the fastest way to check your COVID-19 test results is through the TRICARE Online Patient Portal. If you signed up to receive TRICARE text messaging or emails, you will be notified as soon as your results are entered by the lab. Simply login to TRICAREOnline.com and select the health records tab. Results are listed under the lab test name: SARS-CoV-2.

If your results are positive for COVID-19, stay home and isolate from others in your home. Wear a well-fitted mask if you must be around others in your home. Service members should notify their chain of command. Treatment of symptoms is similar to that of other viral illnesses. Over the counter medications can aid in reducing these symptoms while awaiting a follow-up phone call from BACH staff. Patients experiencing significant shortness of breath should seek emergency care or call 911.
