WOOD/PALLETS (UNTREATED)

POSSIBLE AREAS OF CONCERN

Wood Pallets placed in the dumpsters

CHARACTERIZATION

Wood is considered a solid waste. Fort Campbell's Installation Recycling Policy encourages all installation activities, units, tenants, contractors, and tenant organizations to recycle all recyclable waste including wood.

HANDLING PROCEDURES

- Step 1 Segregate into types of untreated wood (reusable pallets, broken pallets, tree limbs/branches and scrap wood). Treated wood and painted/stained wood cannot be used for recycling and must be separated from recyclable wood.
- **Step 2** Take broken pallets, tree limbs/branches, and scrap wood to the <u>Convenience Center</u>. The attendant will designate which items should be placed in certain containers.
- Step 3 Take good pallets to <u>Convenience Center</u> or supporting SSA. In addition to reusable pallets being sold for recycling, supporting MWR activities, they are collected as part of the Installation pallet exchange program

NOTE: Wood and Pallets must not be placed in dumpsters.



Wood pallets are recycled into mulch.

NOTE: Plastic pallets may be taken to the **Convenience Center** for turn in.
