Ongoing COVID-19 Updates

Air Assault Family Medical Home returns, C Entrance opens, testing location moves

Blanchfield Army Community Hospital's Air Assault Family Medical Home, the hospital's largest family primary care clinic, returned to its original location within the hospital's C Building. The C entrance reopened in conjunction with the relocation.

The hospital's COVID-testing relocated to Building 207 off Bastogne Avenue, near the hospital overflow parking lot. COVID-19 testing remains available by appointment through the COVID Triage Line at **(270) 798-4677**. Triage nurses can provide directions for those unfamiliar with the testing site's new location.

Visitor and mask policies

The current visitor's policy remains in effect. Guests accompanying patients continues to be limited to required medical support individuals only. The outpatient visitor's policy allows a guest to accompany a patient who requires supervision during outpatient visits. The current inpatient visitor's policy also remains in effect with only one visitor authorized in an inpatient room and during the patient's entire hospital stay. Facemasks are required when entering the hospital. Some exceptions may apply, including very young children and certain medical conditions.

BACH expands COVID Vaccine to 12 and older

Blanchfield Army Community Hospital expanded COVID-19 vaccination to all TRICARE eligible beneficiaries age 12 and older. COVID-19 vaccinations are available by appointment only at the Fort Campbell Passenger Processing Center located at 7162 Hedgerow Rd.

Schedule using the link on the hospital's webpage at http://blanchfield.tricare.mil. COVID-19 vaccine appointments are not scheduled through the hospital's telephone appointment line, so beneficiaries must use the link on the hospital's website to schedule a COVID-19 vaccine. Walk-in appointments are not authorized.

BACH is using the Pfizer vaccine, which is administered in two doses 21 days apart, so beneficiaries will need to return for the second dose. Second dose appointments may be scheduled through the Dose 2 link on the hospital's website.

COVID-triage and testing continue to support you and your Family

Beneficiaries with COVID-19 symptoms (fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, loss of taste or smell) or who have been in close contact with a COVID-19 infected person may utilize the TRICARE Online Patient Portal to initiate communications with a BACH COVID-19 Triage Nurse. Patients with COVID-19 symptoms are encouraged to complete a COVID-19 screening questionnaire using www.tricareonline.com. A COVID-Triage nurse will contact patients within 24 hours after submitting the screening questionnaire. Using TOL shortens the time waiting to speak to a COVID-Triage Nurse and allows individuals to complete the form anytime, day or night.

In addition, patients may call the hospital's COVID-Triage line at **(270) 798-4677 (HOSP) or (931) 431-4677**, option 2. After hours, beneficiaries may utilize TOL or call the MHS Nurse Advice Line at **1-800-TRICARE** (874-2273). Nursing staff who support the NAL phone lines can assist beneficiaries with non-life threatening medical concerns and provide further guidance. Beneficiaries experiencing a medical emergency, such a severe shortness of breath or difficulty breathing should call 911.

Health and Wellness

Men's Health Month

This is a perfect time for men to get their annual physical. Healthier men live happier lives. National Men's Health Week is observed annually leading up to Father's Day. Set an example with Healthy Habits – eat healthy with a variety of fruits and vegetables, get regular fitness activity, don't smoke or quit smoking/tobacco products, reduce stress and get regular checkups.

Summer safety

Ticks – If you are bitten by a tick, be wary of circular rashes and flu-like symptoms that include fever, headache, and fatigue, as those may be indications of tick-borne illnesses that may require medical attention. Mosquitoes | **Avoid Getting Bitten** Keep **mosquitoes** away from exposed skin by wearing long-sleeved shirts, long pants, and socks. Tuck shirts into pants & pants into socks to cover gaps in your clothing. Use EPA-registered mosquito repellents when necessary. Follow label directions/precautions closely

Sunscreen - Put on broad spectrum sunscreen with at least SPF 15 before you go outside, even on slightly cloudy or cool days. Repeat after being in the sun for 2 hours, or swimming or sweating.

Missed Drug Take Back Day?

Properly dispose of your expired, unused or unwanted medicine by dropping them in the Drug Drop Boxes placed inside the hospital's Main Pharmacy or Town Center Pharmacy during business hours. Accepted items include: prescription medications, controlled substance medication, over-the-counter medication, vitamins, medicated ointment/lotion, liquid medication in leak-proof containers and transdermal skin patches. Items not accepted include: needles, thermometers, contraband drugs, infectious waste/medical waste, personal care products, business waste, hydrogen peroxide, aerosol cans, and inhalers.
