The Centers for Disease Control recommends 14 vaccines for children birth to age six, which includes chickenpox, diphtheria, Hib, Hepatitis A and B, influenza, measles, mumps, pertussis, polio, pneumococcal, rotavirus, rubella and tetanus. Visitor Policy

Blanchfield Army Community Hospital officials announced updates to its visitor policy July 14. Among the changes, U.S. Army Medical Department Activity – Fort Campbell (MEDDAC) Visitation Policy No. 78 allows:

- One adult visitor may accompany patients during Emergency Center visits and outpatient appointments, including prenatal appointments.
- Patients undergoing a procedure that requires a responsible adult as a condition of release may have a visitor remain in the clinic until discharge.
- Inpatient visitation is limited to two persons who are symptom free of illness. Generally, visitation is open from 08:00am to 10:00pm Quiet hours are from 10:00pm to 06:00am to preserve quality rest and healing for the hospitalized patient.
- Patients in labor may have up to two adult visitors at any time.

Any person with a fever or symptoms of illness should refrain from accompanying the patient. Visitors with symptoms may be asked to depart the medical facility if symptoms are obvious to the staff. Patients and visitors may be asked screening questions upon entering clinical services.

Mask Policy

Wearing a mask remains a requirement within all Department of Defense medical facilities other than the following exceptions: children under two years old, while eating or drinking, or when alone in a room with the door closed. Visitors should frequently sanitize their hands before and after patient contact, restroom use, and touching high-contact surfaces.

COVID Vaccine available to 12 and older

Blanchfield Army Community Hospital expanded COVID-19 vaccination to all TRICARE eligible beneficiaries age 12 and older. COVID-19 vaccinations are available by appointment only at the Fort Campbell Passenger Processing Center located at 7162 Hedgerow Rd.

Schedule using the link on the hospital's webpage at https://blanchfield.tricare.mil. COVID-19 vaccine appointments are not scheduled through the hospital's telephone appointment line, so beneficiaries must use the link on the hospital's website to schedule a COVID-19 vaccine. Walk-in appointments are not authorized.

BACH is using the Pfizer vaccine, which is administered in two doses 21 days apart, so beneficiaries will need to return for the second dose. Second dose appointments may be scheduled through the Dose 2 link on the hospital's website.

✓ Health and Wellness

Summer safety

Ticks – If you are bitten by a tick, be wary of circular rashes and flu-like symptoms that include fever, headache, and fatigue, as those may be indications of tick-borne illnesses that may require medical attention. For more information, contact BACH's Environmental Health Team at **270-412-3979**.

Mosquitoes | **Avoid Getting Bitten** – Keep **mosquitoes** away from exposed skin by wearing long-sleeved shirts, long pants, and socks. Tuck shirts into pants & pants into socks to cover gaps in your clothing. Use <u>EPA-registered mosquito repellents</u> when necessary. Follow label directions/precautions closely.

Sunscreen – Put on broad spectrum sunscreen with at least SPF 15 before you go outside, even on slightly cloudy or cool days. Repeat after being in the sun for 2 hours, or swimming or sweating.
