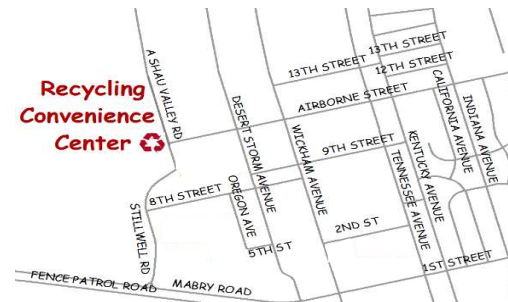

Holiday Recycling

- ✓ **Who:** All Fort Campbell Residents and Military/Civilian Personnel
- ✓ **What:** Recycling drop-off of Christmas trees, cardboard, paper, glass, electronics, scrap metal, aluminum cans and Plastic bottles (#1 and # 2)
- ✓ **Where:** Recycling Convenience Center (CC # 1) Bldg 6802 at intersection of A Shau Valley Rd and Airborne St.



- ✓ **When:** Mon–Fri 8:30 a.m.– 4:30 p.m., Sat 8 a.m.– 4 p.m., Sun 12 p.m.– 4 p.m.
Closed Christmas ,New Years ,Thanksgiving and 4th of July.
DONSA & other Holiday Hours open : 8 a.m.-4 p.m.
- ✓ **Why:** Recycling is a daily activity for more than 100 million Americans, a great way to protect our environment and stimulate our economy. Recycling saves resources, prevents pollution, supports public health, and creates jobs.
It saves money, avoids landfilling, and it's easy.





Holiday Recycling Tips

- ✓ Turn in good boxes and packing materials to the Recycling Convenience Center “Box Exchange”, Bldg 6802 at intersection of A Shau Valley Rd and Airborne St.
- ✓ Recycle cardboard boxes and gift wrap tubes at the Recycling Convenience Center
- ✓ Real Christmas trees can be turned in to the Recycling Convenience Center and recycled into mulch (must be free of all decorations, lights, tinsel and stand)
- ✓ Gift wrapping paper can be recycled (must be free of glitter, foil, cellophane, ribbons or bows). Use other “Green” options for wrapping such as reusing wrapping paper and using newspaper along with reusable gift bags .
- ✓ Plan for next year, gift tags can be made from pieces of Christmas cards
- ✓ Make way for new clothes, appliances and toys. Donate gently used items to places such as the Backdoor Boutique, Goodwill, etc.
- ✓ Unusable electronics can be dropped off in the Convenience Center E-waste container
- ✓ Other waste reduction tips:
 - Buy products made with recycled content
 - Bring your own reusable shopping bag to the grocery store or mall
 - Reduce food waste and compost your inedible produce and food scraps
 - The Recycling Convenience Center accepts cooking oil
 - Use LED holiday lights which consume much less energy and last longer
 - Replace alkaline batteries with rechargeable ones





Christmas Trees, Cardboard and E-waste Collection

- ✓ Christmas trees, reusable cardboard boxes & packing materials may be dropped off for recycling at the Recycling Convenience Center Bldg 6802 located at intersection of A Shau Valley Rd and Airborne St.

Post Operating Status Decision Making Process

- ✓ **In most cases the decision is made and distributed the day/night before.**
- ✓ **What considerations go into the decision process?**
 - Current Weather Forecast
 - School Closures (On and Off Post)
 - Status of the roads from the Provost Marshal
 - Status of road clearance from DPW and Campbell Crossing
- ✓ **Where can I get post operating status information?**
 - Fort Campbell Alert!
 - Fort Campbell Garrison App
 - Fort Campbell Official Social Media Facebook, Twitter
 - Fort Campbell Internet





Operating Status Options

✓ Before the Duty Day Begins

- Post is Open for normal operations
- Post is Open, option for telework or unscheduled leave
- 2-Hour Delay (Emergency Employees report), option for telework
- Post is Closed (Emergency Employees report), option for telework

✓ After the Duty Day Begins

- Early release for Non-Emergency Employees

Note: *Operating Status applies to civilian employees only.
Soldiers should contact their chain of command for instructions.*





What Can You Do?

- ✓ Do not park in the street, it hinders snow removal
- ✓ Residents are responsible for sidewalks and driveways
- ✓ Free salt is available at 1st St. and Tennessee Ave
- ✓ Do not use chemical snow melt
- ✓ Stay off the roads as much as possible, have a vehicle emergency kit if you must travel
- ✓ Call before you leave or use the Garrison App to verify facility is open
- ✓ Spend time with your family and enjoy the snow!

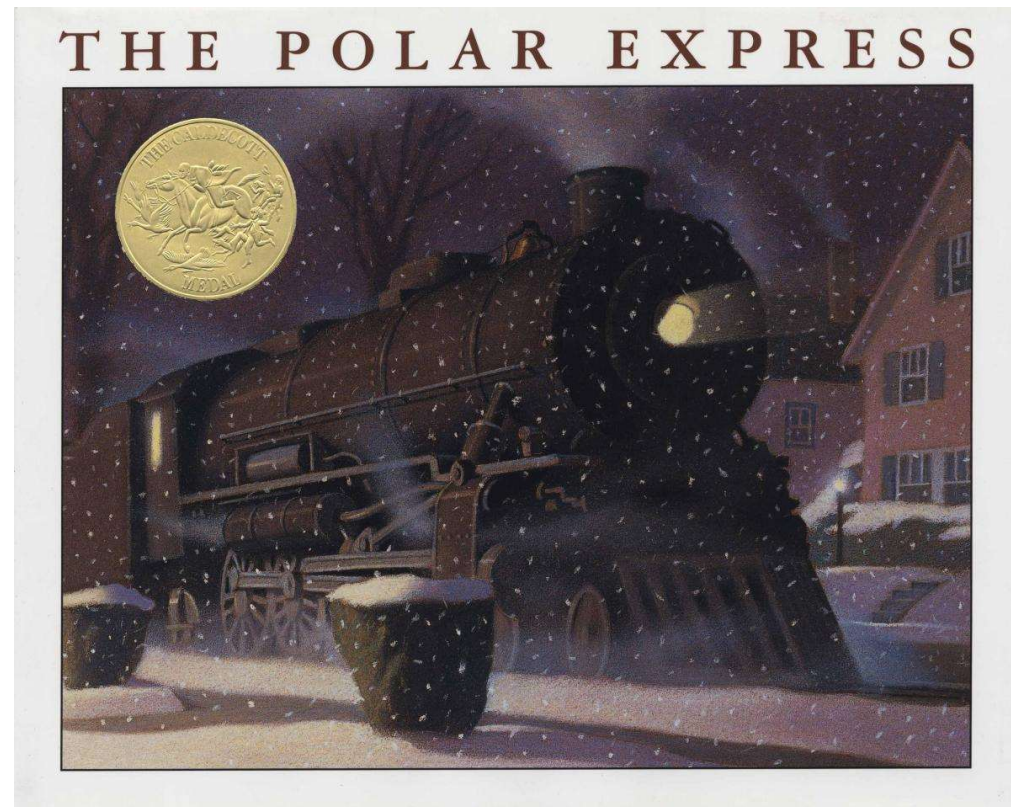
