✓ What: Recycling drop-off of Real Christmas trees, cardboard, paper, glass, electronics, scrap metal, aluminum cans and Plastic bottles (#1 and # 2)

✓ Where: Recycling Convenience Center (CC # 1) Bldg 6802 at intersection of A Shau Valley Road and Airborne Street.

Holiday Recycling Tips

✓ Plan for next year, gift tags can be made from pieces of Christmas cards.

✓ Make way for new clothes, appliances and toys. Donate gently used items to places such as the Backdoor Boutique, Goodwill, etc.

✓ Unusable electronics can be dropped off in the Convenience Center E-waste container.

Operating Status Options

- ✓ Post is Closed (Emergency Employees report), option for telework

After the Duty Day Begins:

✓ Early release for Non-Emergency Employees

- Spend time with your family and enjoy the snow!



✓ TRICARE Open Season

TRICARE Open Season is the annual period when you can enroll in or change your health care coverage for the next year. In 2021, TRICARE Open Season begins **08 Nov 21 and ends 13 Dec 21** Any enrollment changes you make will go into effect on **01 Jan 22**. Open season applies to anyone enrolled in or eligible for a TRICARE Prime option or TRICARE Select.

If you're eligible to participate in TRICARE Open Season, you have three options:

• **Stay in your plan.** If you want to stay in your current TRICARE health plan, you don't have to re-enroll. You'll continue in your current health plan through 2022 or as long as you're eligible.

• **Enroll in a plan.** If you're eligible for a TRICARE Prime option or TRICARE Select but not enrolled, you can enroll in a plan now.

• **Change plans.** If you're already enrolled in a TRICARE Prime option or TRICARE Select, you can switch plans and switch between individual and family enrollment.

If you are happy with your current TRICARE health plan, you don't have to take any action to stay enrolled. Learn more at <u>https://www.tricare.mil/plans/enroll/openseason</u>

Health Themes

✓ Warrior Care Month

Each November, the Army honors wounded, ill and injured Soldiers and their Families by commemorating Warrior Care Month. Warrior Care Month highlights the resilience and strength of these Soldiers and their Families and caregivers. Throughout the month, the Army will host Military Caregiver Symposiums, a Resource Fair and other events honoring these men and women and their Families, communicating the Army's commitment to wounded, ill, and injured (WII) Soldiers, their Families and caregivers. Warrior Care Month increases awareness and understanding of Soldier Recovery Units as it commemorates Soldiers and Families for their service and sacrifice to the Nation.

✓ National Diabetes Month

According to the CDC, diabetes is the seventh leading cause of death in the United States. Adults aged 50 years or older with diabetes die 4.6 years earlier, develop disability 6 to 7 years earlier, and spend about 1 to 2 more years in a disabled state than adults without diabetes. About 34.2 million people—or 10.5% of the U.S. population—had diabetes (diagnosed or undiagnosed) in 2018. BACH patients who are diabetic may attend classes, which are presented on the first Tuesday and Thursday of each month. The classes are three hours and provide information about prevention, maintenance and control of diabetes. Patient's PCM must submit a referral to attend one of the classes.

Ongoing COVID-19 Updates

✓ Third Dose vs. Boosters

If you received the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine for your two-dose primary series, the CDC recommends some individuals receive a single booster dose at least six months after the second dose. You can learn more here:

If you have certain immunocompromising conditions, such as undergoing cancer treatment or taking medications which suppress your immune system, CDC recommends you get an additional dose of a mRNA vaccine at least 28 days after your second dose of a mRNA vaccine. ✓ Mask Policy

Wearing a mask remains a requirement within all Department of Defense medical facilities other than the following exceptions: children under two years old, while eating or drinking, or when alone in a room with the door closed. Visitors should frequently sanitize their hands before and after patient contact, restroom use, and touching high-contact surfaces.

✓ COVID Triage and Testing

Blanchfield Army Community Hospital offers COVID triage weekdays **7:45 a.m. to 3:45 p.m.** and weekends **7:45 a.m. to 11:45 a.m**. via the hospital's appointment line at **270-798-4677**, option 2. COVID testing is available weekdays and DONSAs **8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m**. and weekends **8 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.** Services are available for Soldiers, Retirees and Family members assigned to a BACH or Fort Campbell medical home.

✓ COVID Vaccine available to 12 and older

The COVID vaccine clinic, located at the Passenger Processing Center next to Campbell Army Airfield, is open weekdays from **6:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.** Vaccines are provided on a walk-in basis or you can save time by scheduling an appointment online at <u>https://blanchfield.tricare.mil</u> and follow the steps outlined on the hospital's website.

BACH is using the Pfizer vaccine, which is administered in two doses 21 days apart, so beneficiaries will need to return for the second dose. Second dose appointments may be scheduled through the Dose 2 link on the hospital's website. To schedule an additional dose or booster COVID vaccine, use the directions outlined on the Defense Health Agency Appointing Portal. BACH General Information

✓ Unattended children in the Laboratory's Waiting Room

For the safety of patients and their children, young children under the age of 14 and infants may not accompany their parents for lab or blood drawing appointments. They also may not be left in the lab waiting room unattended during the parent's appointment.
