✓ **"Footprints on Our Heart" - 15 Oct 21 1400**

In conjunction with National Pregnancy and Infant Loss Awareness Month, Blanchfield Army Community Hospital's Labor and Delivery Nurses and Chaplain are hosting a remembrance event on the A building lawn at **1400 Friday, 15 Oct 21**, for parents who have suffered a pregnancy loss or grieved the loss of a child. "Footprints on our Heart" is an annual event for Families who have lost a baby through miscarriage, ectopic pregnancy, intrauterine fetal demise or infant death. BACH organizers are also including Families who have lost older children as well for this community event focused on remembrance and healing.

Other supporters, including friends, neighbors and extended family are also encouraged to attend and participate. This event will feature comments from the hospital chaplain and remembrance activities for participants who wish to send wishes in memory of their baby or child. The event will also allow Families to connect with others who have shared their experience and grief.

✓ **Columbus Day observed**

Blanchfield Army Community Hospital personnel will observe the Columbus Day national holiday Monday, **11 Oct 21**. All outpatient services and pharmacies will be closed. All inpatient and emergency supported services remain open 24/7.

✓ **Blood Drives**

There is always a great need for blood donations, and due to COVID-19, there is now a greater-than-ever need for blood. Ongoing COVID-19 Updates

✓ **Third Dose vs. Boosters**

If you received the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine for your two-dose primary series, the CDC recommends some individuals receive a single booster dose at least six months after the second dose. You can learn more here: <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/vaccines/booster-shot.html>

If you have certain immunocompromising conditions, such as undergoing cancer treatment or taking medications which suppress your immune system, CDC recommends you get an additional dose of a mRNA vaccine at least 28 days after your second dose of a mRNA vaccine. ✓ **Mask Policy**

Wearing a mask remains a requirement within all Department of Defense medical facilities other than the following exceptions: children under two years old, while eating or drinking, or when alone in a room with the door closed. Visitors should frequently sanitize their hands before and after patient contact, restroom use, and touching high-contact surfaces.

✓ **COVID Triage and Testing**

Blanchfield Army Community Hospital offers COVID triage weekdays 0745 to 1545 and weekends 0745 to 1145 via the hospital's appointment line at **270-798-4677**, option 2. COVID testing is available weekdays and DONSA's 0800 to 1530 and weekends 0800 to 1130. Services are available for Soldiers, Retirees and Family members assigned to a BACH or Fort Campbell medical home.

✓ **COVID Vaccine available to 12 and older**

The COVID vaccine clinic, located at the Passenger Processing Center next to Campbell Army Airfield, is open weekdays from 0630 to 1530. Vaccines are provided on a walk-in basis or you can save time by scheduling an appointment online at <https://blanchfield.tricare.mil> and follow the steps outlined on the hospital's website.

BACH is using the Pfizer vaccine, which is administered in two doses 21 days apart, so beneficiaries will need to return for the second dose. Second dose appointments may be scheduled through the Dose 2 link on the hospital's website. To schedule an additional dose or booster COVID vaccine, use the directions outlined on the Defense Health Agency Appointing Portal. This link is on the main page of hospital website at <https://blanchfield.tricare.mil>.

BACH General Information

✓ **Unattended children in the Laboratory's Waiting Room**

For the safety of patients and their children, young children under the age of 14 and infants may not accompany their parents for lab or blood drawing appointments. They also may not be left in the lab waiting room unattended during the parent's appointment.

Wearing a mask when entering the hospital or attending scheduled appointments remains a requirement during the COVID-19 pandemic.

✓ **How do I schedule/cancel appointments?**

If you need to make or cancel an appointment at any of the Soldier or Patient-Centered Medical Homes, you may go online at www.tricareonline.com or you may call **270-798-4677/ 931-431-4677** or if outside the calling area **1-866-524-4677**. - Appointments can be made from **0600-1630, Mon-Fri.**
- Appointments can be cancelled 24 hours a day, seven days a week by leaving a voicemail message.
- Advice nurses may be reached by calling the appointment line
- You can also schedule and cancel appointments online at www.tricareonline.com.
- TRICARE® Online Patient Portal Secure Messaging Services allow patients to schedule web visits with their primary care manager, book appointments, request and review lab and test results, email your care team a question, request medication refills, or request a referral at www.TOLSecureMessaging.com.
