MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Guidance for the 101st Brigade Schools Representatives and Off-Post Service Members Packet Submission Process for the Sabalauski Air Assault School.

1. **Purpose.** Effective 15 July 2025, Brigade-level school's representatives within the 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault) and off-post Service Members will adhere to the following guidance for hard-slot allocations pertaining to the respective courses conducted at the Sabalauski Air Assault School (TSAAS). Packets that are submitted after the NLT date will be at risk for forfeiting a hard-slot and will be directed to show up on the start date of the course as a walk-on.

2. Air Assault, FRIES/SPIES, Rappel Master, Combatives, and Pre-Ranger Courses. For 101st Airborne Division Service Members, completed packets for the Air Assault, FRIES/SPIES, Rappel Master, Combatives and Pre-Ranger courses at TSAAS will be submitted NLT 1300 the Tuesday prior to the start date of the course. For off-post Service Members, completed packets for the Air Assault course at TSAAS will be submitted NLT 1600 10 working days prior to the start date of the course.

3. **Pathfinder.** For 101st Airborne Division AND off-post Service Members, completed packets for the Pathfinder course at TSAAS will be submitted NLT 1600 10 working days prior to the start date of the course.
