Frequently Asked Pharmacy Questions

How do I request refills?

BACH Pharmacy asks patients to request refills two (2) business days in advance through TRICARE online (www.TRICAREonline.com) or by telephone at 270-798-DRUG (3784). Refills may be picked up at Town Center.

<u>NOTE</u>: When your doctor extends an existing prescription, it is a NEW prescription even if you have been taking it and there are no changes.

How can I drop off my request and return later?

Pharmacy waits can be long! Receive expedited drop off and return service at all BACH pharmacies by selecting the "D" Drop-off ticket. When your number is called, let us know exactly what you need - then you are free to go.

Upon return, pull the "R"=ready ticket. Same day pickup is available until 2 p.m. Requests after 2 p.m. are ready the next business day after 10 a.m. Pharmacy holds prefilled medication requests for 14 calendar days.

TRICARE beneficiaries can go to the Humana website at www.humana-military.com to get information on enrollments, referrals and authorizations, claims, behavioral health, TRICARE benefits, network provider information, and TRICARE forms and program materials. Active duty Service members are automatically covered under TRICARE Prime but are still required to complete an enrollment form.

HOW DO I RECEIVE A REFERRAL?

Patients who receive care at BACH should speak with their Primacy Care Manager about submitting a referral for specialty care. Once the referral has been submitted, if the specialty is available within BACH, the clinic will contact you to make an appointment. If the specialty service is not available, your referral will be sent to a network provider. Patients receiving specialty care in the network may call 1-800-444-5445 for assistance.

If your baby is born at BACH, the Vital Statistics team will send the Mother's Birth Certificate copy to DEERS and help register your newborn in TRICARE. The team will also submit for the original birth certificate to Nashville for you to receive your child's official birth certificate. The official birth certificate can be picked up at your county's health department at a later time.

If your baby is born at a network hospital, the Vital Statics team will assist you with registering in DEERS and TRICARE.

Have You Moved Your Enrollment?

Welcome to the Fort Campbell area. Whether you are moving here as part of a permanent change of station, moving here as a retiree, or recently married and new to TRICARE, you must call TRICARE and let them know you are here.

Fort Campbell is located within the TRICARE East Region. You can call TRICARE at 800-444- 5445 to facilitate the movement of your family's healthcare enrollment to Blanchfield Army Community Hospital. Non active-duty TRICARE Prime beneficiaries will receive a primary care manager at one of our five Army medical homes. Active-duty service members will be assigned a primary care manager based on their unit identification code in one of six Army medical homes.

Updating and Correcting the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System

Moving your enrollment can be difficult if you and your family are not enrolled in the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System correctly. You can update your address, phone number and email on your DEERS record by going to "Update and View My Profile" in milConnect.

After you make changes on your personal information tab, scroll to the bottom and click Submit to make sure your updates are made in DEERS. If your personal contact information is not current and accurate, you might miss vital communications. Therefore, you receive address verification notifications in milConnect if you have not edited or verified your personal contact information on file (or if you are a sponsor, for you and your family members) in the last 180 days.

If you need to add or remove family members or update name, gender, Social Security number or date of birth in your DEERS record, please visit the nearest military identification card issuing facility. You can visit the Real-Time Automated Personnel Identification System site locator online to locate the nearest ID card issuing facility. You may need to take specific documents with you to the ID/DEERS facility depending on the change(s) needed. You can visit the milConnect website mentioned above to verify the necessary documents.

Humana Military
