BEST PRACTICES/EVENT

Intentional engagement with family at all levels reinforces trust in command at all levels.

- SFRG meetings and informal comms channels (coffee gatherings, online battalion info hubs, quarterly newsletters, check-ins).
- Soldier “Home/Gone Calendar” and newsletters provide families with easily digestible updates, resources, and opportunities to engage leadership.
- Family events do not have to be large-scale fundraisers.
 - Example: 1-187 IN conducted Field Time Potluck Dinner Event for spouses.

JRTC SUPPORT & LEADER ENGAGEMENT

JRTC Support

Synchronize with leadership to provide presence and support during increased training tempo (care teams).

Intentional leader touchpoints with Soldiers with families before, and after JRTC events.

Leader Engagement Plan

Before JRTC: Commanders direct leaders to conduct deliberate Soldier and family touchpoints.

After Training Events: Leaders conduct reintegration follow ups to identify emerging concerns. Integrating into BDE recovery checklist.

COMMAND TEAM CONCERNS/ALIBIS

Post JRTC Stress

Anticipated rise in relationship stress in the post-JRTC period, heightened by the requirements for RAK Reunion and Week of the Eagles happening soon after we return on top of barge download.

Training Tempo Impact on Families

Separation and uncertainty may elevate stress among families.

Mitigation Measures in Place

Clear communication resulting in predictability driven by effective training management. Town Halls hosted at BN level.

Coordinated support framework leveraging UMT pastoral care, SFRG family readiness, ACS community services, and command leadership engagement to provide comprehensive Soldier and family support.

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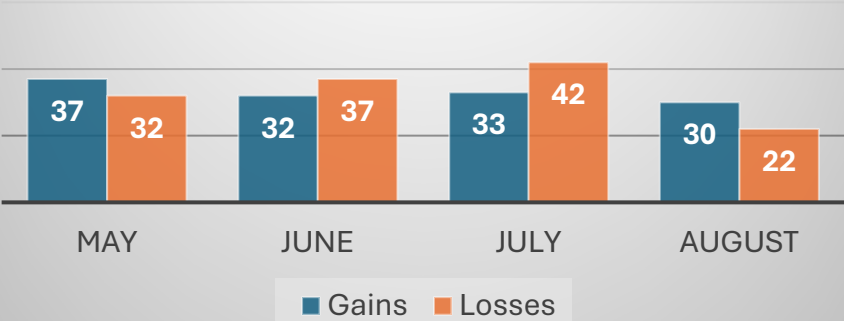

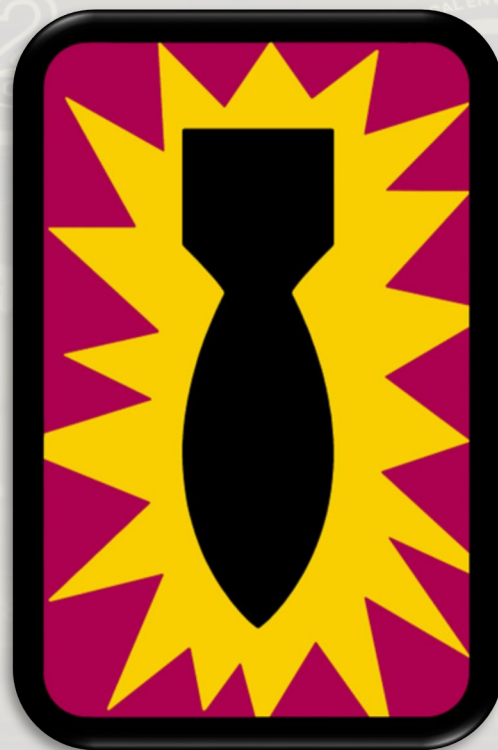
