

Air Assault and TSAAS Courses

Soldiers have the opportunity to attend Air Assault School after completing in processing. You will take an Air Assault assessment while in Kalsu that consists of a 4 mile run in 34 minutes or less, a rope climb, and six chin-ups. Those that pass will join Kalsu's Air Assault program. You then receive a one week train up consisting of the obstacle course, layout, classroom and hands on instruction before attending the next Air Assault class.

For Soldiers already Air Assault qualified, you may have the opportunity to attend a TSAAS course such as Rappel Master, FRIES/SPIES Master, Pathfinder, or Combatives.




