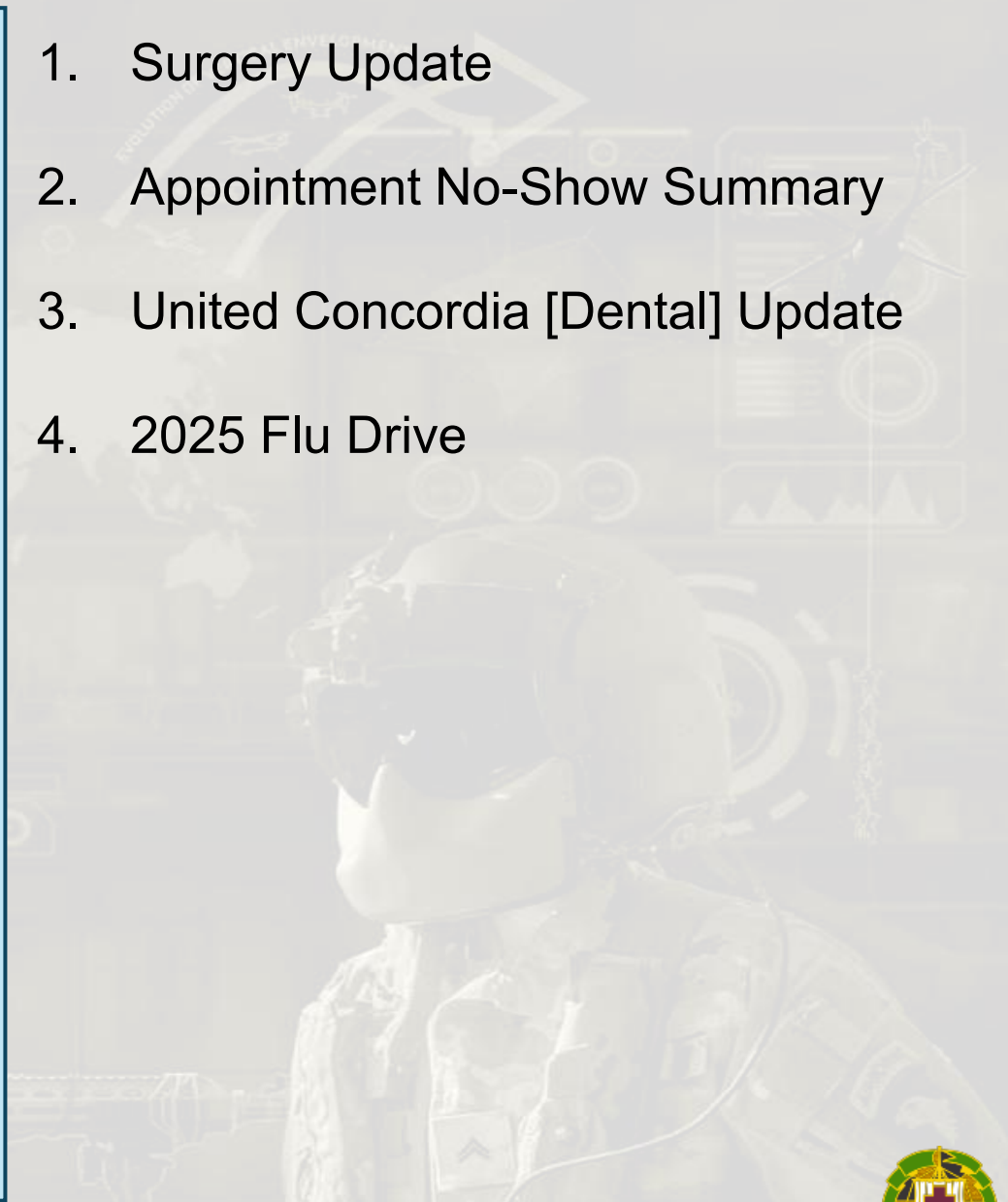
The system will prompt you to enter your (or your sponsor's) DoD ID # along with a few other questions.

Option to pick up from Town Center Pharmacy or the prescription locker system from the hospital's A Bldg. Lobby 24/7

Once the prescription is ready for pick-up, you will receive a text. Plan for three business days – potential for same day if you "Get In Line" before 1400 (2pm).

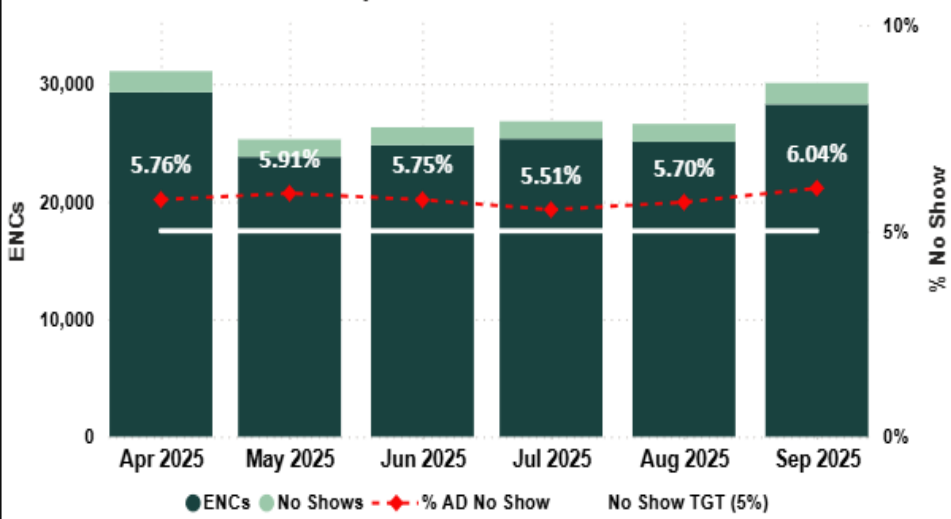


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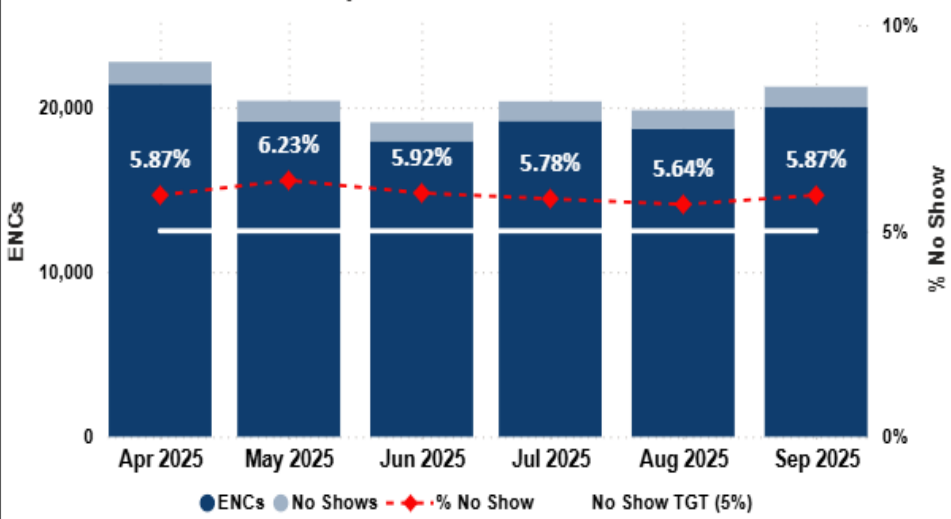

- UCCI will verify access and can make the appointment for the ADFM

31 October 2025 (1800 – 2000)

Have a Group & Have a Plan

- Every child should have a **TRUSTED ADULT**
- Older children should **NEVER BE ALONE** and should have a planned route

Stay Alert, Speak Up

- Teach children to always **BE ALERT**
- **REPORT** anything unusual or suspicious to law enforcement
 - Emergency – 911; Non-Emergency – 931-278-7856

Be Seen

- Wear **REFLECTIVE** clothing and carry a flashlight

Be Careful

- Teach children to **NEVER** approach a vehicle, unless they are accompanied by you



Costume Choice

- **AVOID** costumes that are oversized or have long-trailing fabric
- Ensure eye holes are large enough to see out

Deliberate Decorations

- It is **SAFEST** to use a flashlight or battery-operated candle in jack-o-lanterns
- Keep real candles a far distance from anything that can burn
- Dried flowers, cornstalks, and crepe paper are **HIGHLY FLAMMABLE**

Keep Clear

- Keep children away from open flames
- Ensure **EXITS ARE CLEAR** of decorations

Transporting Privately Owned Firearms (POF)

DO's

- Store your **unloaded** POF in a container separate from ammunition
- Your POF container should be inaccessible to the driver and passengers
- Use a commercial trigger lock or other security device
- Travel in the most direct route to and from your destination (residence, target ranges, hunting areas, etc.)

DON'Ts

- Never have a loaded POF in your vehicle
- Do not store your POF in a glove box, center consul, under seat, etc.
- Never bring an undeclared POF onto the installation.



NOTE: Civilians who register POF for hunting ONLY are NOT granted pass access to bring weapons on the main cantonment area of Fort Campbell.
