MEMORANDUM FOR The Sabalauski Air Assault School (TSAAS) Off-Post Students

SUBJECT: TSAAS Welcome Letter

1. Congratulations on your selection to attend a course at The Sabalauski Air Assault School. Below are the courses at TSAAS with timelines outlined below:
    - a. Air Assault -Day Zero in-processing begins at 0530
    - b. Pathfinder -Day One in-processing begins at 0800
    - c. Rappel Master -Day One in-processing begins at 0830
    - d. FRIES/SPIES Master -Day One in-processing begins at 0830
    - e. Pre-Ranger -Day Zero brief and in-processing begin at 0900
    - f. Combatives (BCC Level I/TCC Level II) -Day Zero brief and in-processing at 1000 at Building 6470 the last duty day the week prior to course start date.
  2. Students will report to the Air Assault Course with the complete prescribed packing list, located on the school website. All students will ensure they have reviewed the packing list and the packing list brief prior to reporting to Day Zero.
  3. Students attending any of our TSAAS courses will require the following:
    - a. Completed Fort Campbell Form FC 4137 ( With valid ATTRS reservation made by TSAAS.)
    - b. Air Assault Course Inserts will require the original drop slip in addition to a updated FC 4137. See the TSAAS website for insert report times.
    - c. Any permanent profile (Temporary profiles will be reviewed by the TSAAS Senior Medic to determine if the Soldier is able to complete the course)
    - d. Official Temporary Duty Assignment (TDY) orders on a DD Form 1610
    - e. Lodging: Service members will need to make their own lodging reservations; no lodging is provided by TSAAS for any students. On post lodging can be located at 77 Texas Avenue, Fort Campbell, KY 42223. Contact Turner Army Lodging by phone at (270) 439-2229 or at [www.fortcampbellmwr.com/lodging/index.html](http://www.fortcampbellmwr.com/lodging/index.html).
1. Students attending Pre-Ranger will have lodging provide throughout the duration of the course at Camp Hinsch.

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f. Transportation: TSAAS does not provide shuttles to and from the schoolhouse regardless of the situation.

g. Flights: Graduation attendance is required, so flights must be scheduled after 1700 on graduation day.

h. Meals: TSAAS does not provide any off post/TDY Students meals, nor do we have any assigned dining facility. SMs will require meal per diem throughout the duration of the course. There are dining facilities located on Fort Campbell that allow all Soldiers to eat at them. If the course works through lunch hours students can fill out a missed meal voucher to get compensation for that meal.

1. Students attending Pre-Ranger will have meals provide throughout the duration of the course at Camp Hinsch.

i. Students will require all equipment IAW the current TSAAS packing list for their respective course, that is available on the TSAAS home page.
