Thank you for submitting the 2021 Final Fifth Five-Year Review Report for the Rocky Mountain Arsenal Site.

The EPA, in consultation with the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, (CDPHE), concurs with your protectiveness determination for the operable unit On-Post (OU3) and Off-Post (OU4).

A summary is enclosed of OU-specific protectiveness statements and the associated issues and recommendations which will be tracked at the EPA. This information will be included in the EPA's annual Superfund Five-Year Review Report to Congress. A sitewide protectiveness statement is not expected until the sitewide construction completion milestone is met.

The Army has agreed to work on all action items on the enclosed issues and recommendations table in the coming years and has been involved in the selection of due dates.

The Environmental Indicators for this site are "current human exposure under control" and "contaminated groundwater migration under control." The due date for the next five-year report is September 28, 2026.
