*When:* Sept. 21, 2023, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

*How:* Drop off all unwanted, unclassified paper, including old bank statements, credit card offers, cancelled checks, old medical records, pay stubs, etc., to shred it and get rid of it. **(No classified documents will be accepted.)** The event is free and open to all ID card holders. Ensure documents brought in are free of trash and non-paper items (binders, paper clips, etc.) for ease of processing.

*Why:* The event is used to increase awareness of Pollution Prevention Week, celebrated this year Sept. 18-23, and to provide a venue for shredding and recycling of paper. Come do your part to help Fort Carson reduce waste from going to the landfill!
