Military vehicle involved in early morning collision on I-25 South

FORT CARSON, Colo. – At approximately 4:15 a.m., a Joint Light Tactical Vehicle (JLTV) was involved in a collision with an SUV traveling southbound on I-25 near Pueblo.

Out of an abundance of caution, four Soldiers were transported to UC Health Park View Medical Center for evaluation.

The Soldiers operating the JLTV were from the 1st Stryker Brigade Combat Team, enroute to Piñon Canyon Maneuver Site for a distributed training exercise that enables units across 4th Infantry Division to train for large-scale combat operations.

A [JLTV](#) is a light tactical wheeled vehicle that replaced the Humvee and is used by the U.S. Army and Marine Corps to support military operations.

Soldiers from Fort Carson are actively working to recover the JLTV and return it to Fort Carson.
