4ID requests community help to find missing Soldier

FORT CARSON, Colo. – The 4th Infantry Division and Fort Carson are requesting the public's help in finding a missing Soldier.

The Soldier is Pvt. 1st Class Aaron Frame, an infantryman assigned to 2nd Battalion, 23rd Infantry Regiment, 1st Stryker Brigade Combat Team, here.

Aaron was last seen in formation at Fort Carson at 5 p.m. on Oct. 17, but failed to report for duty the next morning. His unit leadership and his family have been unable to contact him since then. The exact cause of his departure is unknown.

Aaron is a 20-year-old, white male with brown hair and blue eyes who is 5-foot-10-inches and weighs approximately 186 pounds. He drives a black Kia Forte with Colorado License Plate: AYGU52.

Fort Carson unit leaders and investigators are working closely with Aaron's family, local law enforcement agencies and Department of the Army Criminal Investigation Division to locate Aaron and expedite his safe return to the installation.

The 4th Infantry Division and Fort Carson are committed to the welfare and safety of its Soldiers and their Families.
