Fort Carson hosts mystery event for Best Ranger, Sapper and Medic Competition

FORT CARSON, Colo. – The 4th Infantry Division will host a mystery event to test Soldiers' tactical skills as part of the division's Best Ranger, Sapper and Medic Competition at Iron Horse Park, Friday at 9:15 am.

This year's competition includes 24 Soldiers from units across the installation who are contending for the opportunity to represent Fort Carson and the 4th Infantry Division at the Army-level competitions held in April 2024.

Winners will be announced at the closing ceremony following the mystery event.

The previous days of competition included a max strength test, a non-standard Army physical fitness test, an obstacle course, swim event, weapons qualifications, an unknown distance ruck march, land navigation, technical tasks tests, demolition testing and medical testing conducted over the last three days.
