3rd Armored Brigade Combat Team, 4th Infantry Division to deploy to Europe

FORT CARSON, Colo. – The 3rd Armored Brigade Combat Team, 4th Infantry Division will deploy to Europe this spring.

During the nine-month deployment, the brigade's mission is to reinforce and assure NATO allies and partners while deterring aggression in the region. Last November, the brigade completed a full-scale maneuver and live-fire exercise, culminating in its successful completion of a rotation to the National Training Center in Fort Irwin, California.

"We are deeply honored to support U.S. European Command as well as our European allies and partners in the coming months," said Col. Brian D. Gilbert, the brigade commander. "The dedication and resiliency of our Soldiers, along with the steadfast support of our families and local community, has enabled us to remain a lethal and ready force."
