

ENCLOSURE 2:
168TH RTI, BASIC LEADER COURSE
PACKING LIST

Purpose:

1. This enclosure includes all items required to successfully complete the Basic Leader Course. This page will define the condition of equipment and use of the packing list. All uniforms and uniform components brought for wear must be clean and serviceable.

- a. At no time will Soldiers bring uniforms or uniform components that are faded or have holes, rips, tears, stains, dirty and/or missing pieces of the component.
- b. ASU/ AGSU items must fit properly and be tailored in accordance with Army standards.

2. **FIGURE 1** items are mandatory and required throughout the year. These items will be inspected by the cadre on the day of reporting. Any item that is missing or unserviceable will be annotated, and the Soldier will be counseled for the discrepancies. Any discrepancy that is not corrected within 72 business hours of notification may result in dismissal from BLC for failure to meet prerequisites.

- a. Kevlar Helmet / ACH complete includes cover, pads, chinstrap, and cover band.
- b. The canteens or Camelback hydration system is a mandatory item due to the potential of extreme temperatures experienced during the late spring months, summer months, and early fall months. **The Camelback hydration system may be used in lieu of two canteens with covers on the FLC.**

3. **FIGURE 2** Army Service Uniform/ Army Green Service Uniform (Class A) are the required uniform for graduation. National Guard Students that have not been furnished either a complete ASU or AGSU uniform, must abide by the exception to policy guidance. Any Soldier that fails to provide the complete signed MFR or a complete Class A uniform will result in counseling and removal from honors.

4. **FIGURE 3** Classroom items are critical for the academic success and participation in the Basic Leader Course. Failure to have appropriate classroom materials may hinder student participation and result in counseling and removal from honors.

5. **FIGURE 4** Fort Carson is a high mountain desert climate and is prone to a wide range of temperatures. It is mandatory that Soldiers bring appropriate cold weather clothing and tailor their uniform to the changes in temperature. The items listed in FIGURE 4 are mandatory during classes that occur during the winter months, spanning October through May. Failure to bring any items listed in FIGURE 4 during these months will result in counseling and removal from honors.

6. Soldiers that are traveling from outside of Fort Carson, that are staying in the lodging at 168TH RTI are encouraged to bring the following items, **AS THEY WILL NOT BE FURNISHED BY THE ACADEMY**. This list includes but is not limited to: Towel(s), Laundry Detergent, Toiletries, Soap, Lint Rollers, Minimum 22 Day Supply of Necessary Medication, Appropriate Civilian Attire, Shower Shoes, Personal Laptop or Tablet for Off Duty Entertainment, Headphones, or other Personal Items.
