4ID offers behind-the-scenes look at Ivy Mass

FORT CARSON, Colo. – The 4th Infantry Division invites media to attend a behind-the-scenes look at the ongoing Ivy Mass training exercise May 20 from 10 a.m. to noon at the Piñon Canyon Maneuver Site.

Throughout May, Soldiers have been conducting Ivy Mass, a training exercise that validates Next Generation Command and Control warfighting functions across live and constructive environments at Fort Carson and PCMS. Ivy Mass is designed to stress every element of NGC2 at a division scale and make the 4th Inf. Div. more lethal and prepared ahead of Project Convergence Capstone 6 at the National Training Center this summer.

During this event, media will be taken by Stryker (an armored fighting vehicle) to observe maneuver live-fire training and small unit movements toward an objective. This will also serve as an opportunity to learn about the 4th Inf. Div.'s role in prototyping NGC2 capabilities as the Army works toward rolling out the technology to every major division within the branch of service.
