Media Opportunity **Fort Carson hosts Arapahoe Village ribbon-cutting ceremony**

FORT CARSON, Colo. – Fort Carson and Balfour Beatty Communities will conduct a ribbon-cutting ceremony May 13 at 11 a.m. to celebrate the construction of 56 townhomes that will be incorporated into the installation's Arapahoe Village community.

The ceremony will include remarks from Maj. Gen. David S. Doyle, commanding general of the 4th Infantry Division and Fort Carson, and Theresa Steele, vice president of project development for BBC, followed by a walking tour of three completed townhomes.

The new townhomes will provide housing for 56 Fort Carson Families and will consist of 3- and 4-bedroom floor plans, with one unit specifically designed to meet ADA compliance standards.

The new housing replaces the old Cherokee Village West neighborhood, which was originally built in 1958 and demolished in 2021.
