

- Limited emergency assistance for severe needs (case-by-case only) and much more








PEER SUPPORT GROUPS

- **TBI Education Workshop**: Every 2nd Thursday of each month from 11:30 am – 1:00 pm, Operation TBI Freedom hosts a TBI education workshop for veterans/service members and their family members.
- **TBI Peer Support Group:** Every 3rd Tuesday of each month from 11:30 am – 1:00 pm, Operation TBI Freedom hosts a veterans/service members small TBI peer support group.





Eligibility


Regardless of the discharge status:

- Sustained a brain injury during or after their service

Veterans Diagnosed With at Least One TBI




