Public Service Announcement **Increased military vehicle traffic expected for SH-71, 94 as training concludes at PCMS**

FORT CARSON, Colo. – Military vehicle convoys belonging to the 4th Infantry Division will begin intermittently traveling from the Piñon Canyon Maneuver Site to Fort Carson beginning May 15 and continuing through the end of the month.

Community members and commuters should be aware that approximately 1,400 military vehicles will be traveling intermittently in convoys from the Piñon Canyon Maneuver Site to Fort Carson. This will lead to increased traffic on several state highways. The designated routes for this movement are:

- Primary Route: North on State Highway 71 then west on State Highway 94
- Alternate Route: West on U.S. Highway 350 then north on Interstate 25

Motorists in the vicinity of these routes may experience intermittent traffic delays. For your safety and the safety of our soldiers, please exercise extra caution when driving near military convoys. We advise drivers to maintain a safe distance, be patient, and avoid attempting to pass or merge into convoys.

The movement of vehicles comes as the 4th Inf. Div. winds down its Ivy Mass training exercise and prepares for upcoming combined arms live-fire exercises. This training is crucial for maintaining the readiness of our forces. The 4th Inf. Div. is grateful for the public's continued cooperation and understanding.
