Fort Carson, Colorado Springs Utilities receive Army Community Partnership Award

FORT CARSON, Colo. — The Department of the Army has recognized Fort Carson, in partnership with Colorado Springs Utilities, as one of seven Army installations to receive the 2024 Army Community Partnership Award.

The award, which celebrates the Intergovernmental Support Agreement (IGSA) between the Mountain Post and Colorado Springs Utilities, seeks to highlight examples of exceptional cooperation and diligence that have resulted in improved readiness and will encourage further collaboration to achieve the full potential of community partnering.

The IGSA, or partnership agreement between an Army installation and its state or local government for the provision, receipt, or sharing of installation support services, oversees Colorado Springs Utilities' efforts to provide Fort Carson with superior operations and maintenance of the post's electric and gas systems.

"This award is truly a testament to Fort Carson's commitment to our peak partners and the Colorado Springs community," said Col. Erik Oksenvaag, Fort Carson garrison commander. "Through our IGSA with Colorado Springs Utilities, we have seen improvements in the reliability of our electric and gas distribution systems, a dramatic reduction in off-line systems, and a cost savings of nearly \$300,000 per year."

After initially exceeding expectations, the IGSA was updated to include the operations and maintenance of Fort Carson's water distribution system.

"[Fort Carson's] commitment to innovative partnerships for energy resilience with the potential to expand stood out among all the impressive submissions we received," said Dave Leinberger, chief of Army Community Partnerships, Office of Deputy Chief of Staff G-9 (Installations),
