FORT CARSON, Colo. – The 4th Infantry Division will conduct a live-fire training exercise at Fort Carson, June 3-10.

The exercise dubbed, Ivy Mass, showcases the division's multi-domain operations capabilities alongside joint force partners from the Marines, Air Force, and Colorado Army National Guard.

The large-scale exercise will integrate air, ground, cyber, and space-based systems to demonstrate how the Ivy Division uses converging effects to win on today's modern battlefield.
