Public Service Announcement Front Range Freedom Fest returns to Fort Carson

FORT CARSON, Colo. – Fort Carson's Directorate of Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation will host the Front Range Freedom Fest June 28 from 4–10 p.m. at Iron Horse Park located on post.

The event will include a live rock concert featuring Default, Anberlin, and Vertical Horizon, as well as festival entertainment, food trucks and a fireworks show to end the night.

The event is free and open to those who can access the installation. While admission is free, fees will apply for attractions, food and merchandise.

Pets, apart from certified service animals, glass containers and coolers are prohibited. Weapons will not be allowed at the event site except for authorized law enforcement officials. Personal fireworks are prohibited on post.

Despite the Colorado amendment legalizing recreational marijuana, wrongful use or possession of marijuana on a federal installation is a violation of federal law.
