How: Drop off all unwanted documents, including unclassified work documents, bank statements, cancelled checks, old medical records, paycheck stubs, etc., for shredding and disposal. (No classified documents will be accepted.) The event is free and open to all ID card holders. Ensure documents brought in are free of trash and non-paper items (binders, paper clips, plastic bags, etc.) for ease of processing.
