FORT CARSON, Colo. – Fort Carson's Directorate of Emergency Services (DES) will open the doors to its newest fire station, Station 34, during a grand opening ceremony Feb. 18 from 9:30-10:30 a.m. on Fort Carson.

The new 8,000-square-foot facility, located near Gate 6 along Wilderness Road, will replace the previous Station 34 located at the Turkey Creek Recreational Center and will provide two fire engines to support Fort Carson's firefighting efforts.

Instead of a traditional ribbon-cutting ceremony, leadership from the Fort Carson Garrison and DES will uncouple firehoses, a unique firefighter tradition symbolizing Fire Station 34's activation.
