Public Service Announcement 11ECAB conducts final formation flight

FORT CARSON, Colo. – Charlie Company, 7-158th General Support Aviation Battalion, 11th Expeditionary Combat Aviation Brigade, a unit under the Army Reserve Aviation Command, will conduct a final formation flight Sept. 14 at Fort Carson's Butt's Army Heliport.

In late July, the Army announced it was inactivating Reserve rotary-wing units in accordance with the Army Transformation Initiative.

The final formation flight will include six aircraft and will fly from Fort Carson to Pueblo, Eagle, along the I-70 corridor, and then return to Fort Carson.

An increase in noise along the flight's route can be expected. Fort Carson is dedicated to being good neighbors and will continue to inform the public about training events that may affect surrounding communities. We will continue to listen to our community and work through any noise issues that may arise. We strive to balance our training requirements with respecting our neighboring communities.
