4ID hosts Relinquishment of Responsibility ceremony for Division CSM

FORT CARSON, **Colo**. – The 4th Infantry Division and Fort Carson will host a Relinquishment of Responsibility ceremony for Division Command Sgt. Maj. Alexander Kupratty May 9 from 10-11 a.m. at Founder's Field on Fort Carson.

Fort Carson will welcome its next Division Command Sgt. Maj. later this summer.

Kupratty assumed responsibility as the senior enlisted leader of Fort Carson January 2023. Throughout his tenure, he has advised the commanding general on all enlisted matters and served as the custodian of standards and discipline for the Ivy Division.

Kupratty has been a proactive and communicative leader, marked by initiatives such as "Soldier Summits," which were designed to empower Soldiers and gather feedback to improve quality of life.

As the Command Sgt. Maj. of the 4th Inf. Div., Kupratty emphasized mastering fundamental warfighting skills for both large-scale combat and multi-domain operations. He placed a strong focus on leader development, particularly for junior non-commissioned officers. His leadership philosophy centered on building trust, fostering a positive culture and preparing Soldiers for modern conflict.

Kupratty enlisted as an Infantryman on May 17, 1997. Since attending Infantry One Station Unit Training at Fort Benning, Georgia, Kupratty has served at every leadership echelon in the Army, from team leader to Command Sgt. Maj.
