4ID, Fort Carson honor fallen during Mountain Post War Memorial Ceremony

FORT CARSON, Colo. – A memorial service honoring the 4th Infantry Division and Fort Carson's fallen, known as the Mountain Post War Memorial Ceremony, will be held May 21 at 10 a.m. at Founders Field located on post.

Since 2004, Fort Carson has commemorated Soldiers from the Mountain Post who have lost their lives while supporting overseas contingency operations that began in 2003. A total of 407 names of fallen servicemen and women are inscribed on the memorial stones at the Kit Carson Park located outside Gate 1.

Maj. Gen. Patrick Ellis, commanding general of the 4th Inf. Div. and Fort Carson, will serve as the keynote speaker for the event. Traditionally, the Mountain Post War Memorial Ceremony is held at the Kit Carson Park, however, due to construction, the ceremony will be held on post.
