4ID conducts final iteration of Ivy Sting

FORT CARSON, Colo. – Soldiers with the 4th Infantry Division will conduct its fifth and final Ivy Sting training exercise March 9-13 on Fort Carson.

Ivy Sting 5 will work to scale technology from the division level to the company level, testing units' abilities to integrate, plan and call for fire using the Army's new Next Generation Command and Control ecosystem.

In May, the 4th Inf. Div. will travel to the Piñon Canyon Maneuver Site to conduct Ivy Mass which will serve as a risk-reduction exercise ahead of Project Convergence Capstone 6, where the Ivy Division will scale all NGC2 capabilities to the division level. PCC6 is slated to occur later this summer.
