4th SFAB hosts NATO Medical Evaluation Course at Fort Carson

FORT CARSON, Colo. – The 4th Security Force Assistance Brigade invites members of the media to attend the NATO Medical Evaluation Course's culminating event May 1 from 8-10 a.m. at the Evans Army Community Hospital located on post.

The course, which began its first of two iterations April 28, equips participants with hands-on experience and essential tools for assessing medical unit capabilities, using NATO's Medical Evaluation Manual to standardize medical interoperability and readiness. This is the second time the course has been held in the United States.

Course participants include service members from the U.S. Army, British Army, Canadian Armed Forces, German military and additional international participants from NATO. Course instructors include service members from the United States, Hungary, Portugal, Netherlands and Spain.

Thursday's event will consist of a graded simulation exercise, where media can expect to observe participants working together to apply what they've learned through practicing their ability to assess a unit or installation's medical capabilities.
